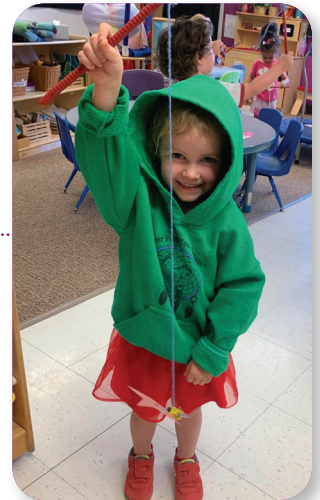
2022 Custer Highlights

The Kidstop afterschool program serves 48% of the Edgemont School K-5 learners providing a safe place to be after school where they receive a snack, homework help, tutoring, and opportunities for additional learning & playing with friends.

The Edgemont YMCA was awarded a 21st Century Community Learning Center Grant through the South Dakota Department of Education to provide financial resources to continue supporting the rural community of Edgemont & surrounding areas with the Kidstop afterschool program.
