

# A MESSAGE FROM THE CEO



#### Dear Members and Y Supporters,

As we reflect on the past year, I am filled with immense pride and gratitude for the progress we have made together. Our YMCA has demonstrated resilience and commitment to our mission and I am excited to share some of the positive highlights and the challenges we have faced.

Our strong leadership team has been bolstered by new team members in Aquatics, Wellness and Marketing, who have brought fresh perspectives and energy to our organization. Additionally, our workforce stability is evident with an impressive 89% retention rate, showcasing the dedication and satisfaction of our staff. With 279 staff annually, we are one of the largest non-profit organizations on the western side of the State. We have also focused on streamlining membership across all centers in the Black Hills, ensuring a seamless experience for all our members.

However, we have faced several challenges. **Grant funding** across the nation is down, impacting our financial stability. For the past two years, the YMCA has operated in a **deficit**, which poses significant challenges. Our **resource limitations** are evident in early learning and youth development, with 310 children currently on the waitlist. Across the nation, **171 YMCAs** have permanently closed their doors, and **12 YMCA pools** have shut down due to the inability to staff certified lifeguards. This workforce problem has impacted our capacity to serve the community as well as fill the demand for essential swim lessons. Moreover, **social connections** are needed now more than ever across all ages, and we are committed to fostering these connections within our community.

Despite these challenges, we remain steadfast in our dedication to serving our community. We are exploring new avenues for funding and partnerships to address our financial needs and expand our programs. Together, we can overcome these obstacles and continue to make a positive impact on the lives of those we serve.

Thank you for your unwavering support and commitment to the YMCA. We look forward to another year of growth and success.


### **WHO WE ARE**

The Jump Start team also helps parents navigate complex systems, such as the childcare assistance application process, and provides ongoing support as families transition into the workforce.



## FACILITY ENHANCEMENTS



In the past several years, we have made significant investments in the infrastructure of our facilities in Rapid City and Custer, totaling \$436,500 and \$63,000, respectively. These improvements, though not immediately visible to our members, were essential to addressing the long-overdue maintenance of our aging facilities.

By focusing on critical infrastructure upgrades, we have ensured the safety, reliability, and longevity of our YMCA centers, allowing us to continue serving our community effectively for years to come.
