Giraffic Park Day Camp is for children who are entering grades second through sixth, fall 2025. Field trip days will either be Tuesday or Thursday afternoon, or all day on Wednesdays. Swimming opportunities will be offered either on Tuesdays or Thursdays. The rest of the time will be spent at camp.
