



KNOW YOUR RIGHTS *as a Whistleblower*

No one should ever be subject to or threatened with reprisal for reporting information on wrongdoing or cause for concern involving a U.S. Department of Education program or operation.

In fact, if you are a Department employee, former employee, grantee, subgrantee, or contractor, it is unlawful for any personnel action to be taken against you because of protected whistleblowing.
