YMCA of Rapid City Announces Name Change to YMCA of the Black Hills

Name change accurately represents the area served by its four YMCA branch locations.

Rapid City, SD — December 30, 2025 — The YMCA of Rapid City today announced that it is changing its name to the YMCA of the Black Hills, effective January 1, 2026. The new name better reflects the organization's broad reach and commitment to serving communities throughout the Black Hills region.

While the name is changing, the YMCA's mission remains the same: to strengthen community through youth development, healthy living, and social responsibility. Programs, services, leadership, and staff will continue uninterrupted, and the organization remains a part of the national YMCA movement.

"Our new name more accurately represents who we are and the people we serve," said Kristy Lintz, YMCA of the Black Hills Chief Operations Officer. "With branch locations in Rapid City, Box Elder, Custer and Edgemont, YMCA of the Black Hills better reflects our role as a regional organization committed to supporting individuals and families across the Black Hills, now and into the future."

The name change is part of a broader effort to align the YMCA's identity with its growing impact beyond Rapid City, and eliminates confusion between the physical Rapid City branch and its larger association. The organization will begin transitioning signage, web and email platforms, and communications materials in the coming months.

Community members, members, donors, and partners can expect the same valuable YMCA programs and welcoming environment they have always known — now under a name that better represents the YMCA's regional presence and vision.
